FROM HISTORY OF CONFERENCE:

The first conference was organized by Transport & Logistics Departments of University of Gdansk in May 1992. In the period 1992-1999 the conferences were focused on „*The problems of Polish inclusion to the European transport system*”. The main topics covered integration and transformation of transport systems in the different European countries as well as present transport policy problems. Towards the Polish preparation to the EU membership, in 2000-2006 the main idea of debates was focused on “*Adaptation of Polish transport to the European Union*”. Latest XVI International Conference under the title INTRALOG 2007 „*New trends in transport and logistics. Symbiosis of transport and ecology-quality approach*” was held in June 2007.

AIMS OF CONFERENCE:

- Exchange of views and discussions on the contemporary trends in transport & logistics development;
- Promoting the results of transport research and discussion on the new research directions;
- Integration of scientists and practitioners.

CONFERENCE TOPICS:

1. **Ecological challenges for transport – contemporary economy issues** (trends in economy and sustainable development, sustainable development in view of economic recession);
